

Self-Evaluation

At the 30th RCA General Conference held in Vienna on 15 September 2001, the MSs were informed of the evaluation training/workshops intended to provide skills and tools to RCA MSs to undertake evaluation of RCA project activities. The 3-part workshop included a 3-day training in April in Vienna, a 2-month intermission period, and a 1-week follow-up workshop in Thailand in July 2001. The 9 participants* who completed the workshop were tasked to do an evaluation of RCA training events specially those conducted under the joint UNDP/RCA/IAEA project RAS 97/030.

The MSs were requested to give support to these trainees who will do the evaluation exercise and prepare a report on the results of the exercise, which will be presented at the next RCA Meeting of National Representatives.

The selected trainees met on 11- 13 March 2002 in Vienna and presented the results of their study.
