


# Progress on the Partnerships with the ADB

## Background

- Preliminary discussions followed by a proposal for collaboration between the ADB and the RCA on energy planning submitted to the ADB on 2 April 2021 by Mr Prinath Dias (PAC Chair)
- Initial meeting held on 19 April 2021 attended by ADB, RCA FP, PAC Chair and RCARO
  - Identified common interests in establishing partnerships on the area of energy planning with the possibility of extending to other areas at a latter stage
- The 43<sup>rd</sup> RCA NRM(April 2021) welcomed the partnership initiative and approved the RCARO to follow up the progress to establish a partnership project with the ADB

## Actions Taken

- Virtual meetings (May, June) held attended by ADB, IAEA TC, RCA FP, PAC Chair and RCARO
  - Shared the view on cooperation framework
    - ✓ A separate MOU between the ADB and the IAEA on energy planning
    - ✓ Cooperation Framework Agreement between the IAEA and the ADB signed in 2018
      - \* energy planning, RCA are not included
  - Agreed to organize a joint activity in energy planning with a possibility of further extending the collaboration at a later stage

## Future Possibilities

- Further extending the initial collaboration with ADB in Energy Planning under a new Framework Agreement if necessary.
- Establishing collaboration between RCA and ADB under the existing Framework Agreement between IAEA and ADB in areas of Agriculture and Food Safety, Climate Change, Environment, Human Health, and Water Resources.

## Proposed Actions

- The meeting may
  - take note of the progress made in establishing collaboration between the RCA and the ADB;
  - approve a joint event in Energy Planning and request the IAEA to organize one as a first step; and
  - approve RCA FP and RCARO to continue negotiations with ADB to establish collaboration under the existing Framework Agreement or under a new Agreement if the need arises.
