RCA Guideline and Operating Rules Part 4, Sec 7

7. Copyright of the Derivative works of the IAEA/RCA project

7.1 In creating a derivative work such as e-learning modules from an IAEA/RCA product, the author of the derivative work will make prior and full consultations with the IAEA Secretariat to avoid any infringement of the copyright of the IAEA.

7.2 In creating a derivative work based on an IAEA/RCA product, if the attribution of the information indicates that the information (including photos and graphics) is from a source or site external to the IAEA/RCA, the author will ensure that they will get permission for reuse of the information from each originating organization/person. It should also be acknowledged in the derivative work that it is created based on an IAEA/RCA project outcome.

7.3 If IAEA/RCA product is translated for publication, then such translation must also contain notification that the translation is not an official IAEA/RCA translation and that the IAEA/RCA takes no responsibility for the accuracy of the translation.
