Functions of RCA PAC

1. Advising the National RCA Representatives on the following matters related to the RCA Programme.

- The procedures for development of RCA Cooperative Projects
- The procedures for implementation and monitoring of RCA Cooperative projects
- The procedures for evaluating and recording achievements of completed projects

taking the RCA Medium Term Strategy into consideration.

Functions of RCA PAC

- Carrying out responsibilities delegated to the PAC by RCA NRs in implementing the above mentioned procedures
- Contributing to identification and recommendation of project ideas, concepts and design phases for the RCA projects
- Coordination of the development of the RCA Regional Programme Framework in consultation with the RCA Chair, RCA Focal Person and the WG on drafting the RCA MTS

Functions of RCA PAC

- Advising the RCA NRs on revising the RCA GOR on development, implementation, monitoring and evaluating RCA Cooperative Projects
- Providing inputs to the development of the RCA Medium Term Strategy
- Functioning as the RCA Research Review Committee (RRC)
- Any other relevant matters delegated to the PAC by a meeting of the NRs.

MTR - Recommendations

- Use of outcomes of baseline and mid-term reviews to improve the RCA programme
- The need for a final review should be decided based on the above.

Number of projects

- designed and implemented with participation of end-users : GOR Part 1, 1.7 (j)
- with final evaluation reports submitted within the specified time: GOR – Part 4 1.2.1 (g)

PI 3 - Programme Sustainability

3.1 Financial Resources

Consider using the percentage of Extra Budgetary funds out of the total RCA budget as an indicator.

Other Issues

Funding

- Implementation of the recommendations of MTSC to 40th NRM
 - Enhancement of IAEA TC funds
 - Enhancement of Extra Budgetary funds from RCA Government Parties - RCA Agreement Article V(3)
 - Partnerships with regional (eg. ADB) and international development agencies

Human Resources Development

- Implementation of recommendations to 40th NRM WG on HRD
 - Duration of RTCs (two weeks instead of one)
 - Assessment of knowledge of participants at the beginning and end of the RTCs
 - Maintaining a repository of training material used in RTCs
 - Group Fellowship training with the support of regional Universities

- Addressing special needs of New GPs
(Recommendation 2 of 8th MTSC Meeting)
 - Virtual meeting with NRs of new GPs, with participation of RCA FP, MTSC Chair and PAC Chair
- Duplication of RCA and non-RCA projects
- RRU
 - Feedback from NRs on revised GOR (Annex 36)?
